



Callaway Golf Staff Pro Jim Thorpe Wins with ERC Fusion Driver, HX Tour Golf Ball; U.S. Women's Open Winner Uses HX Tour Ball

Callaway Golf Staff Pro Ben Bates Tops Nationwide Event

CARLSBAD, Calif.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--July 6, 2004-- In a resounding Fourth of July weekend for Callaway Golf (NYSE:ELY) clubs and balls, the Company's explosive ERC Fusion Driver had its fourth professional win in the past five weeks, the hugely successful HX Tour Golf Ball won its second major championship in a month at the U.S. Women's Open and the Nationwide Tour champion used a full complement of Callaway Golf equipment to top the field at Hershey Country Club.

Callaway Golf(R) Staff Professional Jim Thorpe won for the second time in a month on the Champions Tour, using Callaway Golf equipment to stage a successful defense of his title at the Commerce Bank Long Island Classic. In a come-from-behind victory, Thorpe used the powerful combination of the ERC(R) Fusion(R) Driver and HX(R) Tour Golf Ball -- a pairing that has now produced 13 worldwide professional wins. Thorpe also used the Steelhead(R) III Strong 4-wood, Hawk Eye(R) VFT(R) Irons and Odyssey(R) White Hot(R) 2-Ball Blade Putter to close with a 3-under-par 67 for a 1-stroke win.

Thorpe's quick start on Sunday with three birdies on the front nine helped him overcome a four-shot deficit for his ninth Champions Tour victory. "I'm in kind of a groove and I'm really striking the ball well right now," Thorpe said. "The combination of the Fusion Driver and the HX Tour ball is working great for me."

The HX Tour Golf Ball and Odyssey Rossie(R) 2 Putter were among the keys to victory at the U.S. Women's Open, where the champion put on an amazing putting display to win her second career Open. She also had four Callaway Golf fairway woods in her arsenal (4-strong Steelhead Plus(R), Big Bertha(R) 5-wood, and Steelhead III 7- and 11-woods) as she edged Callaway Golf Staff Professional Annika Sorenstam by two strokes.

In a putting performance the champion called "magical," she had 10 one-putt greens Sunday (24 putts overall) en route to a record final round 65, 6-under-par. "I'm beside myself. I haven't putted like this in, I can't tell you how long. Just to stand over the putter like that and have these amazing putts go in was so much fun," she said. Odyssey Golf is part of the Callaway Golf family of brands; Callaway Golf also won the iron, wood and putter equipment counts at the 59th U.S. Women's Open.

At the Nationwide Tour's Reese's Cup Classic, Callaway Golf Staff Professional Ben Bates birdied the final hole in regulation play and then prevailed in an eight-hole playoff. Bates carried a bag full of Callaway Golf equipment, including the CTU 30(R) Red Golf Ball, Great Big Bertha(R) II 415 Driver, 3-strong Steelhead Plus and Steelhead III No. 5 Fairway Woods, Steelhead(R) X-16(R) Pro Series Irons, Callaway Golf Forged Wedges and an Odyssey Dual Force(R) 990 Putter.
